- Support good governance as Growing Links grows and develops
- Help us make the best use of grants, contracts, earned income and community investment
- Ensure our financial decisions remain aligned with our social and environmental mission
- Bring an independent voice, curiosity and sound judgement to Board discussions

You might come from finance, accountancy, business, social enterprise, charity finance or another field where you have developed strong financial and strategic skills. You do not need to know everything.

What matters to us is that you understand good financial governance, are willing to ask thoughtful questions, and share our belief that organisations should serve people, community and planet.
